



# A Night at the Movies

## Pre-Visit Information

We are thrilled your school will be joining us at the National Film and Sound Archive (NFSA) for A Night at the Movies, our exclusive film screening program for school groups, during your Canberra excursion.

A Night at the Movies includes approximately 12 minutes of pre-show entertainment before the feature film. This segment includes a short video explaining the history of film projection, followed by a selection of vintage advertisements from the NFSA collection.

## Facilitation

A Night at the Movies is not a facilitated event. However, NFSA Visitor Services staff will be on hand to help seat your school in the theatre and assist you with any enquiries while you are onsite.

Other NFSA spaces may be open to the public or other private events during your visit. Students must be accompanied by teachers or accompanying adults associated with the excursion at all times.
